Great music—Safely enjoyed! **Guidelines for Concerts**

Our 2020-2021 season will be filled with great music to enjoy however you feel safest. Keeping our audience and musicians safe guides all our plans. At the Saenger, seats and rows will be blocked to accommodate social distancing, and masks covering nose and mouth are required. All concerts will be professionally videoed and will be available online to members who do not feel comfortable attending in person. Concerts are limited to approximately one hour without intermission. Four performances – 6:00 p.m. and 8:30 p.m. on Saturdays and 1:00 p.m. and 3:30 p.m. on Sundays.



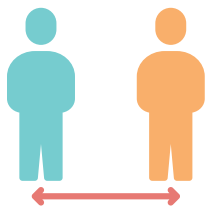
Masks (covering nose and mouth) are required at all concerts and must be worn throughout the performance as well as when entering and leaving the theater.

Please bring your own face covering.



Hand sanitizers are available at entrances, exits and at various other points in the theater.

Programs will not be reused. Please take your program home or drop it in the marked containers.



Seating will comply with social distancing guidelines.

- We will skip rows and allow for ample room between households and individuals.

- Please maintain at least a six-foot distance during the performance and while entering and exiting the Saenger.

- Do not reseat yourself to rows or seats that are marked off.

- Do not congregate.

Tickets will be scanned for contactless entry and seating.

The theater will be sanitized according to CDC guidelines between performances including seating areas and frequently touched surfaces.



Do not crowd restrooms. Practice social distancing throughout the theater.

Handwashing stations are available in all restrooms. **Wash hands at least 20 seconds** before leaving the restroom.
