Please prepare the following:

1. Major Scales

2 Octaves - The judges will select two Major Keys

2. A Solo of your choice from the standard repertoire for your instrument.

A concerto, concert piece, or sonata is strongly recommended.

3. Excerpts (Listed Below)

You should prepare these excerpts to the best of your ability. The tempo indications are only suggestions. While you may not be able to play at the indicated tempo, you are expected to make a reasonable effort to perform each excerpt. It is strongly recommended that you consult your private teacher in your preparation and that you listen to these excerpts on YouTube.

Excerpt 1: Night on Bald Mountain

Notes:

1. This excerpt is marked "*Allegro Feroce*" (Fast and Fierce)
2. Play it around $\text{♩} = 100$ (In 2)
3. Pay attention to accents and dynamics
4. Look for bowings and bow strokes
5. Play near the frog and use as much bow as possible when FF.
6. **Hint: This passage shows your character and power.**

Excerpt 2: Night on Bald Mountain

Notes:

1. This passage is the same tempo marking as the first excerpt.
2. Do not play divisi. Play all of the double stops together.
3. Pay attention to dynamics and bowings.

Excerpt 3: Symphony No. 2 – Borodin (MVT 1)

Notes:

1. This excerpt is marked “Allegro” (Fast) *Allegro* $\text{♩} = 120$
2. Watch the metronomic indication.
3. Pay attention to dynamics, fermatas, and accents.
4. Play it with a lot of bow and strong sound.

Excerpt 4: Symphony No. 2 – Borodin MVT 4

Notes:

1. This excerpt is marked *Allegro*
2. Play is around 120bpm
3. Watch the key (SHARPS)
4. Play using spiccato or as short as possible on the lower part of the bow.
5. It is pianissimo except the last chord.
