

MSO Strings in Schools *Register now!*



Beginning in 2nd grade you have the opportunity to learn the violin **during the school day** in your school! Professional musicians from the Mobile Symphony teach weekly group strings classes.

When and how do we start? Classes begin meeting in September.

How many lessons are there? There are 25 strings lessons during the school year, the academic school year is 35 weeks long. Due to school field trips, holidays, testing and MSO teacher's schedules, these lessons may not occur on consecutive weeks.

How long is a lesson? 45 minutes

How much does Strings Class cost? There is no cost for Strings Class at Orchard Elementary School. This program is fully funded by the school.

We do expect you to come prepared to your classes with your instrument, treat your violin with respect, and attend all classes.

Do I need to have my own instrument? No, Orchard Elementary students will be loaned a scholarship instrument, to use for the year, on the first day of class.

What should I expect? To have fun! But to get the most out of the class you will need to practice at home at least 15 minutes a day. Join us at one of our Parent Orientation dates to talk with MSO staff and ask questions!
