Every time I hear the musicians of the Mobile Symphony play, I'm awestruck by the sound they create – totally committed, passionate, swift, thrilling, lyrical, singing, virtuosic. Just as true and rich, just as full of vitality, just as faithfully created before your eyes and ears, as in the biggest cities in the world.
